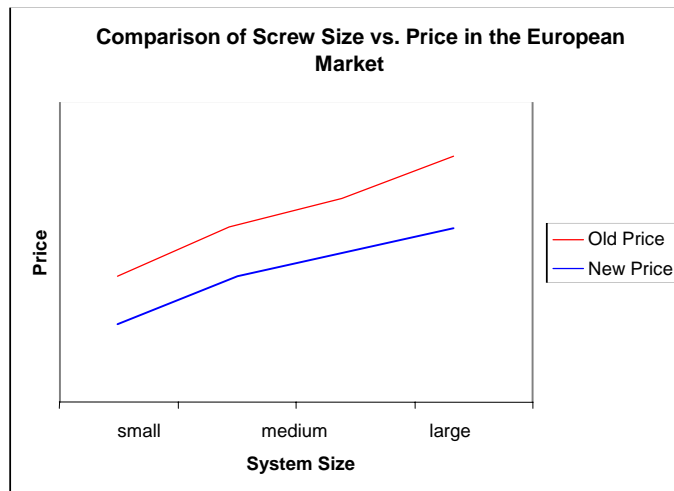

Trexel No Longer Requires Licenses for its MuCell® Molding Systems

below 100,000 Euros.

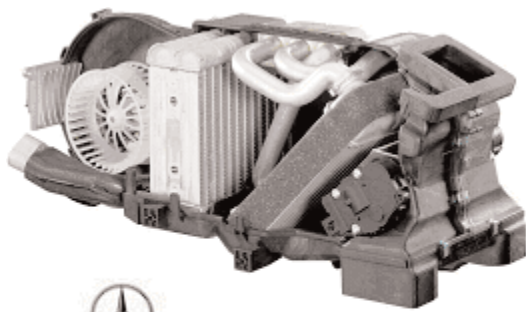
